




Digging in: Worship and the Word at Home (Paperback)

Each week they ll listen to the accompanying CD and sing along to help them learn the verse. Some times they can pick a worship song of their own to sing or play a homemade instrument and some weeks they may play a game or draw pictures. The possibilities to study God s Word are endless in this upbeat devotional. With space for notes, review sections, and an appendix of quizzes, internalizing the Word of the Bible, a seemingly impossible task for some, has become easy for young children, as well as busy moms and dads.
